

Terms of Payment
ABP PATENT NETWORK AG,
Othmarstrasse 8, 8008 Zurich

1. Invoiced services are to be paid within 14 days upon receipt of invoice. The payment must have been transferred to the bank account of ABP PATENT NETWORK AG on the 14th day after receipt of invoice.
2. Objections to the content of an invoice are to be raised within 14 days upon receipt of invoice and will not be accepted after expiry of that term.
3. Cash discounts shall be inadmissible without any exception.
4. The second (and at the same time last) reminder carries a fee of EUR 10.00.
5. According to Section 352 Austrian Enterprise Code (UGB), the interests on arrears amount 8% above the respectively applicable basic interest rate. Interest on arrears will be charged beginning on the day the last reminder has been dispatched.
6. Pursuant to Section 1333 paragraph 2 Austrian General Civil Law (ABGB) and in addition the statutory interests, the creditor is entitled to claim the debtor for compensation of further damages caused by the debtor and arising to the creditor, in particular the costs that are necessary for appropriate collection measures in court and out of court, to the extent that said costs are reasonable in relation to the debts being collected.
7. The client gives his/her revocable agreement that all data concerning himself/ herself being disclosed between the parties due to the contractual relationship will be processed supported by automation and passed on to a collection agency or a lawyer for reasons of creditor protection and for making our debts collectible.



8. In the event that the address of the client changes, he/she shall inform the contractor. Until the contractor has received said information, all Communications by the lawyer to the client shall be deemed to have been received if they are sent to the address communicated by the client when retaining the lawyer.
9. Unless there are peremptory statutory provisions to the contrary, the parties submit all their disputes arising out of or in connection with contractual relationships to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at the seat of ABP PATENT NETWORK AG.
10. All and any legal relationships with ABP PATENT NETWORK AG shall be subject to Austrian substantive law without regard to its conflicts of law provisions under international private law.
